She has a clinical practice in High Point, N.C., and is President of Dermatology Consulting Services, a research company founded in 1988 to provide education, perform adverse reaction evaluation, and conduct clinical studies in association with the pharmaceutical, skin care, and nutraceutical industries. She has been a visiting professor at more than 45 medical institutions nationally and internationally.

Prior to pursuing a medical career, Dr. Draelos completed an undergraduate degree in mechanical engineering and was elected a Rhodes Scholar. A member of Sigma Xi research honorary and Alpha Omega Alpha medical honorary, she is author of the textbook Cosmetics in Dermatology, now in its third edition, and has written eight textbooks, contributed chapters to 23 textbooks, written 300 published papers and currently serves on eight journal editorial boards. She is the editor-in-chief of the Journal of Cosmetic Dermatology and received a cosmetics industry lifetime achievement award from Health Beauty America for her research contributions in topical formulations in 2006.
